<b>GUIDELINES FOR GRANT APPLICANTS</b>	
<b>Section 1.4.3 Type of projects</b>	<p>More detailed definition of Infrastructure and important note added: “Infrastructure means permanent works and/or permanent installation of equipment which contribute to at least one Programme (common) output that is specifically addressed by the project.” <i>Take note that: Stand-alone acquisition of equipment and endowments that do not require permanent installation is not considered infrastructure.</i></p>
<b>Section 2.2.1 Eligibility requirements for the Applicant and partners</b>	<p>Correction of the footnote: <i>For the present Call for proposals, the same Applicant may submit no more than 7 projects, one for each Priority.</i></p>
<b>Section 2.4.2 Project’s contribution to the Programme</b>	<p>The following phrase concerning the Programme indicators has been corrected: A project will only be selected if it demonstrates its effective contribution to at least one Programme (common) Output (specific for the Priority chosen) <del>and or</del> to at least one of the corresponding Output indicators.</p>
<b>Section 2.6.5 Supporting documents accompanying the Application Form</b>	<p>Minor addition to the text: <i>“Certificates of fiscal registration or equivalent of the Applicant and each project Partner”</i></p>
<b>Chapter 6 Glossary of terms</b>	<p>More detailed definition of the infrastructure: permanent works and/or permanent installation of equipment which contribute to at least one Programme (common) output that is specifically addressed by the project.</p>

<b>Annex A.1 Justification of costs</b>	<p>Description of heading 7 Information and visibility actions and for heading 9 Administrative costs has been corrected: <i>“7. <b>Application form</b>	<p>Section A3 - project duration – according to the JOP, the minimum period for a project is 12 months. The current value of 6 months has corrected (from 6 to 12 months).</p> <p>Budget line 5.3. Translation, interpreters – a new formula has been added.</p> <p>The application form was renamed <i>2.0 Application Form</i> as to distinguish it from its previous version.</p>
