The purpose is:

- Prevention of emergency situations caused by man-made disasters by improving the water sewage system infrastructure located in the proximity of Danube Delta Border area throughout construction, rehabilitation and modernization works of 11,226 km sewage network, 2 pumping station set up in Izmail city and Izmail District and rehabilitation of 1,315 km sewage network, 1 wastewater treatment plant and 2 wastewater pumping stations of Tulcea County Hospital.
- Enhancing the stakeholder's capacity to prevent, monitoring and control
 of emergency situations caused by man-made disaster in Danube Delta
 Border area throughout implementation of joint cross border actions:
 setting up 1 Joint Monitoring System, development of 1 Joint Crossborder Investment Euroregion Strategy and 1 common Capacity Building
 Program.

Improved sewage system in Izmail by 11.226 kilometers of collection and sewage network system rehabilitated and 2 sewage pumping station in Izmail city and Izmail District rebuilt and modernized;

Improved sewage system in Tulcea by **1.315** kilometers of sewage network rehabilitated, **1** wastewater treatment plant and **2** wastewater pumping stations with obtained functioning
