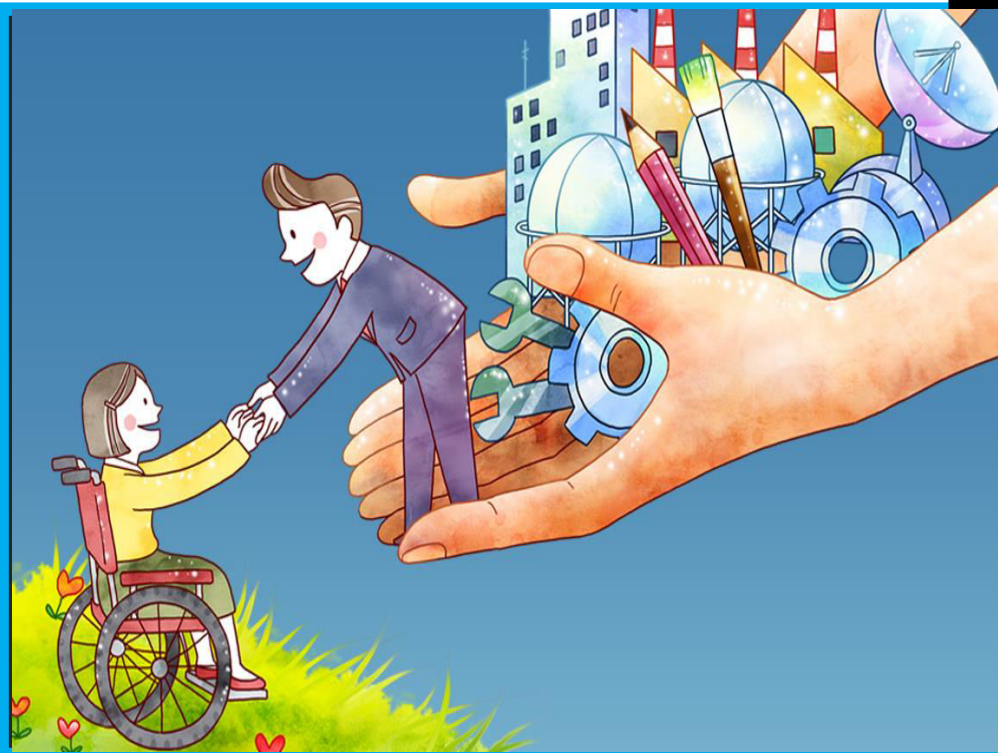

The partnership:

The purpose is:

- Development of the material base from the targeted schools and center in order to allow the development of some activities for disabled students physical rehabilitation (kinetotherapy lab, speech therapy lab, sport field) and for their professional skills achievement (endowment of the workshops), increasing in this way the attractiveness of the special educational system;
- Good practices and know-how exchange on the continuous professional development of the teachers and non-teaching staff, in order to permanent satisfy the inclusive education system needs (acknowledgement of the disabled people problems, and use of the means for them, alternative and argumentative communication system, educational materials and techniques designed for students with SEN);
- Providing the educational services for the children with SEN from Hlyboka district, through the establishment of a new Inclusive Center, which will ensure the children's right general and complete education, access to professional education and to the university level education, based on each child skills, through the necessary methods.
