The purpose is:

- Supporting and educating 200 youngsters at risks aged 14 and 20 years, through programs that stimulate creativity, innovation and active citizenship that are made possible by the creation and development of 2 multifunctional centers that offer integrative support service packages and 4 extra-curricular activities (art of film and photography, traditional crafts, ICT and entrepreneurship programs);
- Supporting and educating through exchange programs and trainings of 40 specialists, in order to teach them extra-curricular activities and socio-economic counseling methods destined to prevent the school abandonment to favor the school reintegration of youngsters at risk aged between 14 and 20 years old.

Project outcomes

4 institutions using programme support for cooperation in education, R&D and innovation;

15,000 people benefitting from all types of activities that received funding within the CBC programme;

2 educational institutions rehabilitated/modernized - creating and modernizing the space for 2 multifunctional where the support services and extra-curricular activities for youngsters at risk are held;

200 youngsters at risk with new practical skills necessary for fulfilling job requirements;

40 teachers and educational experts specialized to provide a wider spectrum of extracurricular activities;

1 online platform destined to facilitate the cooperation between institutions, teachers and youngsters at risk;

1 bilingual guideline with step-by-step instructions needed to offer support;

1 manual that describes the creative workshops;

1 project website for promotion of the activities and results;

4 extra-curricular creative educational activities (ITC basic training, non-formal entrepreneurship training, traditional crafts, photography and video);

1 integrative counselling services package to provide vocational counselling, familial counselling, evaluation of competences and labour market guidance and also to teach the participants about these competences.

Target groups and final beneficiaries

Abt. 240 young people aged between 14 and 20 years old, with a risky situation registered within Technical High school of Dolhasca and High school in Chernivtsi, teachers and educational experts from Suceava, Romania
