## Target groups and final beneficiaries

**20** Students and 8 teachers of the Universities located in border regions in Ukraine and Romania, 1 University in Zakarpattia region and 1 University in Suceava County, Researchers and young innovators of the Research Centres, 72 representatives of Local Communities and authorities of two border regions (Zakarpattia region and Suceava County), 3 pilot communities in Zakarpattia region and 3 pilot

communities in Suceava, 24 Representatives of SMEs and 80 experts of professional institutions and NGOs *have participated to the project activities.*

10 entities: universities, local communities, research institutions *will benefit from the project results on the long term.*
