### The purpose is:

- To improve the material base related to the emergencies of medical institutions of the Chernivtsi oblast and Suceava County hospitals by the end of project implementation.
- To increase the knowledge and practical skills of target groups in emergency medicine through trainings by the end of project implementation.

## **Project outcomes**

**1,130,000** people covered by improved health services as a direct consequence of programme support

1 medical service infrastructure units improved: premises of surgery department in Zastavna CDH

New emergency/ surgery/ diagnostics equipment received by all **3** hospitals involved

**250** medics from project target groups, who took part in project actions,

**150** non-medical workers from target group who received information about first emergency aid / participated in project actions

### Target groups and final beneficiaries

Decrease the number of newly registered cases of illness caused by the consequences of emergencies in Suceava and Chernivtsi regions by **20%** 

Reducing the number of people affected by untimely or poor quality of medical care in the emergency situations and occasions at least by 40%

Abt. 24,750 people: medical staff from Chernivtsi oblast hospital of Gura Humorului, primary healthcare medics, transport and road services staff, rural institutions staff have participated to the project activities.

Abt. 1,130,000 inhabitants of the Chernivtsi oblast and Gura Humorului city will benefit from the project results on the long term.
