

## The purpose is:

- To improve the material base for minimally invasive surgery in the Chernivtsi and Suceava regional hospitals by the end of project implementation.
- To unify the medical protocols of Ukraine and Romania for current treatment by the end of project implementation.
- To increase the level of theoretical knowledge and practical skills of target group in health care through trainings.

#### **Project outcomes**

- **1,545,000** people covered by improved health services as a direct consequence of programme support
- 1 medical service infrastructure unit improved: Regional municipal non-profit enterprise "Chernivtsi Regional Clinical Hospital"
- 1 functional center of minimally invasive surgery in the Chernivtsi Regional Hospital
