#### The purpose is:

- To increase the reaction capabilities of project partners with the purchase of six specialized vehicles.
- To develop the abilities for intervention and to increase awareness among population, in the field of the measures that are necessary in order to prevent natural/ anthropic disaster and to react and respond when they occur, with emphasis on flood prevention, forest fires and heavy snow falls.
- To exchange know-how and experience and to improve cooperation between partners by running several joint actions in order to develop common tools and approaches as to prevent and to respond to emergency situations.

## **Project outcomes**

- **13,431** people benefiting from flood protection measures:
- **4** joint actions including soft operations as well as joint infrastructure investments in the field of emergency situations and the prevention of man-made disasters
- 2 common specialized trainings.
- 2 trainings for the population;
- 1 local resources map with the aim to run a local resources mapping process (resources map) which is meant to identify the companies,

- institutions and individuals providing volunteer equipment and services in case of emergency.
- **1** integrated intervention tools set for the prevention and mitigation of natural and anthropological risks (set of integrated intervention tools).
- 4 specialized personnel/technicians that will be operating the vehicles will receive specialized training in order to use them properly, as for the communities to get the highest benefit from the specialized vehicles and to avoid any accidents.

## Target groups and final beneficiaries

40 Local authorities' personnel directly involved in emergency situations prevention and response have participated to the project activities.

13,431 citizens of the Bistra Municipality (RO) and Bychkiv Municipality (UA), will benefit from the project results on the long term.
