The purpose is:

- Improve the safety of local citizens of Danube Delta region through implementation of cross-border early warning system in case of emergency.
- Increase the capacity of firefighters of Danube Delta region through purchase of new equipment and development of joint action plan for firefighters of Ukraine and Romania in case of emergency.

Project outcomes

- **10,000** people benefiting from flood protection measures
- **4** joint actions including soft operations as well as joint infrastructure investments in the field of emergency situations and the prevention of man-made disasters
- **11** early warning sirens installed in Odessa region
- **4** trainings of municipal state authorities and firefighters


Average response time for emergency situations in the eligible area is decreased by 3%

- **1** joint cross-border action plan in case of emergencies is adopted by both RO and UA regional firefighting inspectorates.
- 1 Feasibility study of Early Warning System in UA developed.
- **2** institutions endowed with specific equipment for firefighting.

Target groups and final beneficiaries

60 professional firefighters in Reni District, 40 professional and voluntary firefighters in Isaccea and 100 public administrations staff members in Odessa region and Tulcea county have participated to the project activities.

Inhabitants of Reni District (37,243) and Isaccea town (4,955) will benefit from the project results on the long term.
