The purpose is:

- To increase the capacity of the local communities to prevent and intervene in case of flooding through joint actions and integrated systems.
- Raising the awareness in the field of efficient risk prevention and management in the cross-border area by transferring the know-how and experience.
- Intensification of the information flow between the local public authorities in the cross-border area related to the emergency situation and preparing the population in case of flooding.

Project outcomes

1,468 people benefiting from flood protection measures;

7 joint actions including soft operations as well as joint infrastructure investments in the field of emergency situations and the prevention of man-made disasters

3 operative centres within the local committees for emergency situations in Candesti Township and Hlyboca district strengthened and prepared for jointly collaboration in prevention of the natural disasters (floods) and action during emergency situations.

10 Volunteers activating in the operative centres within the local committees for

emergency situations from local public authorities;

68 Citizens from cross border area located within the Siret river basin and its affluents informed and prepared in dealing with the emergency situations.

100 Pupils from schools in the targeted area taught about how to react in case of floods.

1 shelter will be constructed in the Candesti locality, by modernisation of the former "braiding section", a building found in the public property of lead beneficiary

300 persons will benefit from the shelter in case of emergency situations.

Target groups and final beneficiaries

10 Volunteers from Hlyboca district and Candesti township; 50 Citizens from cross border area Romania-Ukraine (localities within the Siret basin); 6 Media representatives from Botosani county and Chernivtsi region; 100 Children from primary and secondary schools from Hlyboca district and Candesti Township ; employees of Emergency Situations Inspectorate (ESI) from Botosani and the State Emergency Situations (SES) from Ukraine -District Department of Hlyboca **have participated to the project activities.**

16,427 citizens from Hlyboca district and Botosani/Suceava counties, from localities found in potential danger of flooding; about 40 economical entities in Hlyboca district and Botosani county **will benefit from the project results on the long term.**
