

- Increasing the level of cross border cooperation through joint workshops and exercises, by the end of project implementation.

Project outcomes

8 joint actions including soft operations as well as joint infrastructure investments in the field of emergency situations and the prevention of man-made disasters

1 common alert notification platform in place

2 institutions having an improved/upgraded capacity to respond to emergency occurrences

100 professionals from Romania and Ukraine trained in workshops and exercises.

2 institutions involved in emergency situations and 100 employees of emergency situation institutions involved in project have participated to the project activities.
