

- Strengthening institutional and technical capacity to maintain and restore public order in the cross-border area as well as in support of the specialized structures that are fighting the organized crime
- Increasing the cooperation between the public order structures of the partners in order to achieve a unitary approach of events with crossborder impact
- Increasing the presence of the law enforcement services and reducing the time for the intervention in the cross-border region
