The purpose is:

- Rehabilitation / upgrading of 3 km of cross-border road Izvoarele Sucevei - Shepit.
- Increasing accessibility to various objectives for all user groups located in urban and rural areas in the proximity of cross-border transport infrastructure.
- To develop local, cultural and economic tourism by rehabilitating / modernizing direct cross-border transport links, thus promoting the exchange of experience between Romania and Ukraine.

Project outcomes

3 km- Total length of reconstructed or upgraded roads;

Increased cross border traffic volume in the cross-border area Izvoarele Sucevei - Shepit with 1% in the border area;

Increase in the number of tourists by 1% in the cross-border area;

Target groups and final beneficiaries

Abt. 28,000 people located in urban and rural areas in the proximity of cross-border transport infrastructure have participated to the project activities.

Abt. 1,800,000 residents of Suceava county and Chernivtsi region, tourists, companies, SMEs will benefit from the project results on the long term.
