- Development of a common cross-border framework for environmentally friendly transportation by conducting international conference and Common strategy for environmentally sustainable transport development in cross-border region

Abt. 300,000 people crossing the BCP Shepit-Izvoarele Sucevei per year and citizens of adjacent regions (Putyla and Vyzhnytsya Districts, South-West Districts of Ivano-Frankivsk Oblast, North-East of Suceava County) will benefit from the project results on the long term.
