The purpose is:

- Improving infrastructure and equipment of CCCH in Chernivtsi and SEH in Suceava for raising accessibility of emergency medical care to children of cross-border region by the end of the project
- Raising professional skills of medical staff of CCCH in Chernivtsi and SEH in Suceava in children emergency care and related areas by the end of the project
- Introduction of cross-border telemedicine between project partners and introduction of local telemedicine in CCCH as a way to improve the quality of medical services in CCCH in Chernivtsi and in SEH in Suceava by the end of the project



Project outcomes

1,598,000 people covered by improved health services as a direct consequence of programme support

1 medical service infrastructure unit improved: Constructed and equipped- Emergency Department through reconstruction of existing Department of Surgery and building of thermobox in CCCH in Chernivtsi

72 Medical staff RO and UA trained to provide emergency care and surgery to children aged 0-

18 years, with special attention to children aged 0-1 year.

1 Implemented telemedicine at the local level in CCCH in Chernivtsi by the end of the project

1 Implemented cross-border telemedicine between CCCH in Chernivtsi and SEH in Suceava for raising quality of medical services

Target groups and final beneficiaries

Abt. 182,000- Children aged 0-18 years that are living in Chernivtsi region and 131,000- Children aged 0-18 years that are living in Suceava county, 45 representatives of medical staff of Municipal Medical Establishment "Children's Clinical City Hospital" that provides emergency medical care, intensive care and resuscitation to children, surgeons and traumatologists in Chernivtsi city, 27 representatives of medical staff of Suceava Emergency Hospital "Sf. Ioan cel Nou" that provides emergency medical care, intensive care, surgeons, infant orthopaedics and neonatologists in Suceava city, **have participated to the project activities.**

909,000 People that live in Chernivtsi region, 689,000 People that live in Suceava county, 1 Health local system of Chernivtsi and Chernivtsi region that will increase its potential and improve level of health services and 1 Health local system of Suceava and Suceava county that will increase its potential and improve level of health services **will benefit from the project results on the long term.**
