The purpose is:

- To improve health services within the RO-UA border region by developing the rehabilitation facilities for people with special health condition in the towns of Baia Spria and Rakhiv
- To build a rehabilitation facility with water complex for physical state improvement in Rakhiv, Ukraine that will in future contribute to the improvement of health services in Rakhiv and the district by the end of the project implementation
- To modernize the Baia Sprie Elderly Home Care in Maramures, Romania with the aim to improve living conditions, health and social services by the end of project implementation

Project outcomes

- **108,000** people covered by improved health services as a direct consequence of programme support
- 2 medical service infrastructure units improved: Rehabilitation of Baia Sprie Elderly Home Care and building a rehabilitation facility with water complex
- 1 awareness campaign
- **2** capacity building exchange events with at least **50** participants for experts dealing with social care for elderly people, involving relative experts from Ukraine and Romania.

Target groups and final beneficiaries

Abt. 100 elderly people left without family care in Baia Sprie, 150 Kids with special physical needs in Rakhiv, 50 Health care specialists in Rakhiv, 20 people from Social Services Department of Baia Sprie City Council and employees of Baia Sprie Elderly Home Care, 4,000 Disabled adults from Rakhiv, 50 Health care specialists from Rakhiv, 10 Rehabilitation experts from Rakhiv have participated to the project activities.

108,000 Population of Rakhiv district and the residents of villages adjacent to Baia Sprie will benefit from the project results on the long term
