- To unify the emergency medical protocols in Ukraine-Romania cross-border area by the end of project implementation

100 trained Ukrainian and Romanian medics

Target groups and final beneficiaries

Abt. 500 Medical staff (doctors and nurses), working in Suceava county hospital and in Chernivtsi Emergency Hospital in departments related to urgent medical aid; 603 Doctors and nurses working in Chernivtsi Emergency Hospital who provide assistance in the therapeutic section and do not provide immediate emergency care and cardiopulmonary resuscitation; 500 Students studying in Bukovinian Medical University; 340 Doctors and nurses, working in 11 district central hospitals of Chernivtsi oblast in departments that normally provides emergency medical aid **have participated to the project activities.**

Abt. 1.545.000 residents of Chernivtsi region and Suceava county and 131,000 transients that annually visit the region **will benefit from the project results on the long term.**
