

The purpose is:

- To build a new Center for Alternative Therapies in Recea, Maramures county comprising 7 medical offices for specific therapies, a sensorial park and a large arena for innovative therapy with animals (horses, poney and dogs) and to rehabilitate the alternative therapies section from Children Clinical Hospital Ivano- Frankivsk, comprising 3 medical offices, 1 big sport hall and access lobby by the end of the project implementation.
- To improve the competences and performances of 9 therapists working in the Center for Alternative Therapies Recea, Maramures county and 5 therapists working in the alternative therapies section from Children Clinical Hospital Ivano-Frankivsk through specific trainings and exchanges of experiences, by the end of the project implementation.
- To enhance the knowledge about the causes and risks of having children with various disabilities of the population living in Maramures county and lvano Frankivsk city, focused on at least 20000 inhabitants considered fertile population, from the group of age 20-39, through awareness campaigns conducted on both side of the border.

Project outcomes

775,958 people covered by improved health services as a direct consequence of programme support

2 Improved infrastructures for alternative therapies for children with disabilities in Maramures and Ivano-Frankivsk

14 Better qualified therapists working in the 2 centers for alternative therapies through special trainings and exchanges of experiences.

20,000 Fertile population from Maramures and Ivano Frankivsk better informed on causes and risks of having children with disabilities within awareness campaigns conducted on both side of the border.

Target groups and final beneficiaries

105 - children (age 0-18) with various disabilities from Maramures county, benefitting annually of alternative therapies health services at the new Alternative Therapies Center Recea, 70 children (age 0-18) with various disabilities from Ivano Frankivsk city that will benefit annually from alternative therapies in the rehabilitated alternative therapies section of the Children Clinical Hospital Ivano-Frankivsk, 615 families of the children with various disabilities from Maramures county and Ivano Frankivsk city, benefitting annually free of charge of alternative therapies health services at the new Alternative Therapies Center Recea, Maramures county and rehabilitated alternative therapies section of the Children Clinical Hospital Ivano-Frankivsk, 14 therapists working in the Alternative Therapies Center in Maramures and in Children Clinical Hospital Ivano Frankivsk and 20,000 fertile population from Maramures and Ivano-Frankivsk who will be informed within awareness campaign focused on causes and risks of having children with disabilities have participated to the project activities.

523,858 people from Maramures county covered by health services provided in the alternative therapies center and 252,100 people from Ivano-Frankivsk city covered by health services provided in the alternative therapies department of Children's Clinic Hospital Ivano-Frankivsk will benefit from the project results on the long term.



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
