The purpose is:

- Enhancing the efficiency of the competent authorities to fight organized crime in the border area of Romania - Tulcea County and Ukraine - Odessa region by modernizing the police infrastructure and endowing 3 police structures and improving road traffic monitoring infrastructure of 2 LPAs during the implementation of the project
- Strengthen bilateral police cooperation relations in the border area Romania - Tulcea County and Ukraine - Odessa region by organizing 4 exchanges of experience and joint participation in 18 capacity building sessions on improving investigative methods, verifying information and cooperation for 360 policemen in the field of preventing and fighting against cross-border organized crime
- Increasing population's confidence and security in the cross-border area Romania - Tulcea County and Ukraine - Odessa Region by organizing a Public Campaign to Prevent and Combat Organized Crime, adopting a Joint Cooperation Strategy and a Common Protocol on Cooperation and Intervention in Combating organized crime between 5 police structures and 4 LPAs during the implementation of the project.

4 common experience exchange organized for LPA and police structures

1 common cooperation and intervention protocol adopted

1 Joint Cooperation Strategy adopted

Increasing level of the population confidence in the cross-border area Romania - Tulcea county and Ukraine - Odessa region in the police structures

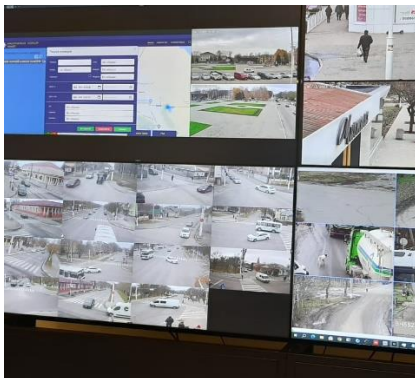
Increasing the road traffic safety in the context of preventing and combating cross-border organized crime
