The purpose is:

- The equipment of "Sf. Ioan cel Nou" Emergency County Hospital Suceava with a scintigraph needed for the Medical Oncology Department that will reduce the needed time for the diagnostic, giving in the same time a clear diagnostic, contributing to the growth of efficiency and quality of the medical act and to the patients and medical staff satisfaction.
- Improvement of activity indicators within "Sf. Ioan cel Nou" Emergency County Hospital Suceava and of the image of Suceava county through the investments made regarding the health infrastructure endowment.
- Creation of the needed conditions to ensure an optimal level of health and for the growth of inhabitant's life quality from the cross-border area by improving the medical services offered.

Project outcomes

1,654,783 people covered by improved health services as a direct consequence of programme support

1 medical service infrastructure unit improved: Medical Oncology Department from "Sf. Ioan cel Nou" Emergency County Hospital Suceava

1 informational and awareness session regarding the prevention and cancer diagnosis for the medical staff from "Sf. Ioan cel Nou" Emergency County Hospital Suceava and from Regional Municipal Non- Commercial Enterprise "Bukovinian Clinical Oncology Center"

Increasing the number of consultations registered among the population from the cross-border area Suceava-Chernivtsi, as a result of

the endowment of medical unit with a scintigraph - approximately **4** consultations / day.

Increasing the satisfaction level of the patients and the medical staff as a result of the procurement of a scintigraph, based on questionnaires – by approximately **50 %**;

Reducing the morbidity rate with **5%** in the next 5 years by performing scintigraphy examinations of patients in the early stages for various pathologies (mostly oncological) that complement the treatment and therapeutic conduct.

Target groups and final beneficiaries

Abt. 25,638 patients diagnosed with different types of cancer that will benefit from the medical services at "Sf. Ioan cel Nou" Emergency County Hospital Suceava; 29 doctors, the nurses, the assistants and other specialized medical staff that are carrying out their activity at the Medical Oncology Department from "Sf. Ioan cel Nou"; 20,286 patients diagnosed with cancer from Chernivtsi region **have participated to the project activities.**

Abt. 1,654,783 residents of Chernivtsi region and Suceava county **will benefit from the project results on the long term.**



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
