The problem. Project's solution

Botosani and Ivano-Frankivsk face common challenges such as environmental degradation, low ecological awareness, and insufficient infrastructure in urban green and blue zones, which puts pressure on local biodiversity. The project addresses these issues through a joint Action Plan for biodiversity protection, infrastructure improvements in two recreational lake areas, and awareness campaigns. By promoting sustainable blue-green infrastructure management and citizen engagement, the project enhances ecosystem resilience, safeguards biodiversity, and creates healthier, greener, and more inclusive urban environments for both communities.
