Both Carei and Khust face increasing risks from climate change and natural disasters, including floods, wildfires, and earthquakes, amplified by outdated emergency infrastructure and limited preparedness. The project provides solutions by modernizing emergency equipment, training personnel through joint exercises, and developing a standardized cross-border cooperation plan. It also promotes innovation through AI-based disaster prediction and community engagement, thus enhancing climate adaptation, prevention, and resilience in the RO-UA border area.

- **2 technical workshops** on evacuation plans
- **1 Workshop on AI in disaster prevention and management**
- **1 Cross-border Cooperation Plan** for disaster risk prevention and resilience in Carei and Khurst
