The problem. Project's solution

The border regions of Botoșani (Romania) and Chernivtsi (Ukraine) face limited communication coverage for emergency authorities, reducing the efficiency of interventions during natural or man-made disasters. The project improves response capacity by upgrading communication infrastructure, purchasing modern ICT equipment, and establishing a know-how transfer mechanism between Romanian and Ukrainian partners. Joint training and awareness campaigns will strengthen cooperation, ensure faster response, and enhance community safety across the border area.
