The problem. Project's solution

The cross-border region faces critical healthcare challenges: outdated medical infrastructure, shortage of trained staff, limited first aid knowledge, and disrupted access to health information due to the war for Ukrainian citizens.

The project addresses these through new medical equipment in Izmail, a Legal Service facility in Tulcea, joint training programs, first aid workshops, and two international conferences. Through these efforts, the partners aim to making healthcare stronger, respond better in emergencies, and build lasting partnerships between communities on both sides of the border.
