The problem. Project's solution

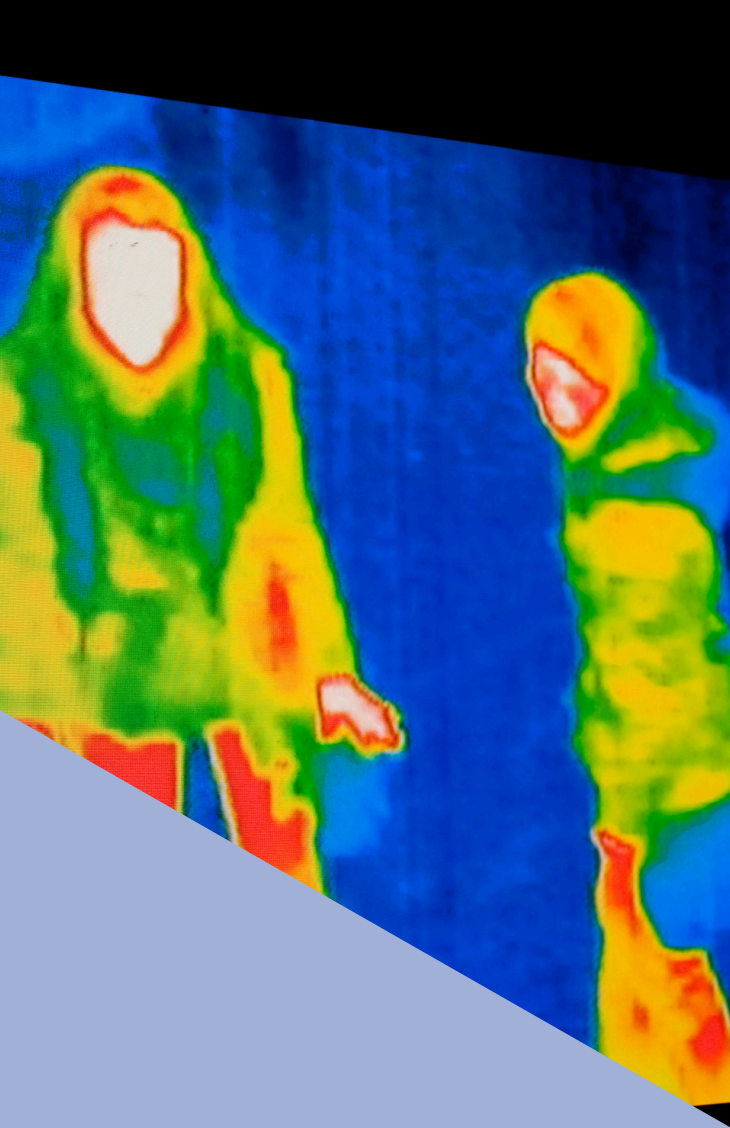
The Romanian–Ukrainian border faces growing challenges from illegal migration and cross-border crime, worsened by difficult terrain, regional instability, and increased migration flows caused by the war in Ukraine. To address these issues, the project strengthens border management through joint training of gendarmerie and border forces, acquisition of modern surveillance and patrol equipment, and coordinated intervention exercises—enhancing cooperation, preparedness, and security along this critical EU external frontier.
