The project addresses these issues by investing in advanced laparoscopic and rehabilitation equipment, and by implementing comprehensive training for surgeons and therapists. This integrated approach improves surgical outcomes, shortens recovery times, and enhances cross-border medical expertise, ensuring better, more accessible care for patients in both regions.

- **abt. 6,544 persons** will benefit annually from the modernised health care facilities
- **Endowment of Andrii Novak Transcarpathian Regional Clinical Hospital** with specialised equipment for laparoscopic abdominal and urological surgery and the patients rehabilitation process
- **Endowment of County Emergency Hospital Dr Constantin Opris Baia Mare** with specialised laparoscopic equipment for general surgery and urology
- **20 rehabilitation specialists** will participate in **6 sessions of training on rehabilitation** after limb injuries, burns, consequences of stroke, spinal cord & peripheral nerves injuries, etc
- **15 surgeons will participate in 2 sessions of training** on mastering practical skills for laparoscopic technologies
- **23 surgeons will participate in a training program** on General Surgery
- **2 International Medical Forums** in Baia Mare and Uzhhorod, one in Surgery and Urology, and one in rehabilitation
- **4 organisations** cooperating across borders
