The problem. Project's solution

The health systems in Tulcea and Izmail face similar challenges: limited investment, outdated equipment, and insufficient training and awareness tools.

The project addresses these gaps by providing modern medical furniture endowments for County Hospital in Tulcea and advanced diagnostic and surgical equipment for Izmail City Hospital. It also builds on previous cooperation to promote telemedicine, emergency response protocols, and joint training, strengthening healthcare services across the cross-border region.

Project Outcomes

- **abt 2,000 persons** will benefit annually from the modernised health care facilities
- **Endowment of the Tuberculosis Department of the Tulcea County Hospital** with medical furniture for stocking and locking the medical consumables, support trolleys for adjacent compact equipment, and for other technical moving.
- **Endowment of Izmail City Central Hospital** with specialised equipment as non-invasive lung ventilators, diagnostic laparoscope, thoracoscope, nephroscope, etc
- **1 awareness campaign-** 6 Information seminars in Odesa region
- **6 training workshops designed for 84 medical professionals** from Tulcea County and 36 from Odesa region
- **2 organisations** cooperating across borders
