The problem. Project's solution

Breast cancer and other cancers have high incidence and mortality rates in the crossborder region between Suceava County and Chernivtsi Region, with limited access to early diagnosis and treatment.

By developing awareness campaigns, improving medical facilities, and providing specialized training for healthcare professionals, the partners are tackling these issues. Cancer-related mortality can be reduced, and the quality of life for affected individuals can be improved if prevention is enhanced, early detection is put in place, and cross-border partners work together.
