The problem. Project's solution





- Sânmiclăuş primary school rehabilitated and endowed (solar and photovoltaic panels, ventilation system, heat pump, laptops, printers, touch monitor, etc)
- Rakosh Gymnasium rehabilitated and endowed (STEM lab & resource room, laptops, 3D printer & scanner, interactive board, projector, etc)
- 1 Cross-border School Workshops & Cooperation, with 2 workshops gathering 40 participants
