Special schools in Suceava County and Chernivtsi Region face challenges related to outdated teaching methods, insufficient educational resources, low student motivation, and limited cross-border cooperation. The project addresses these issues through classroom digitalization, personalized intervention tools, teacher training, inclusive learning environments, and cross-border activities that support the education, social inclusion, and future employability of children with Special Education Needs (SEN).

- **Endowment of Inclusive Education School Center "Sf. Andrei" Gura Humorului** (for mechanical workshop, therapy rooms, teaching materials for teachers, professional training kits, speech therapy platform kits, digital equipment for classrooms, equipment for sports halls, equipment for physiotherapy rooms)
- **Endowment of the Storozhynets Lyceum** (teaching materials, digital equipment, and other equipment for children with SEN).
