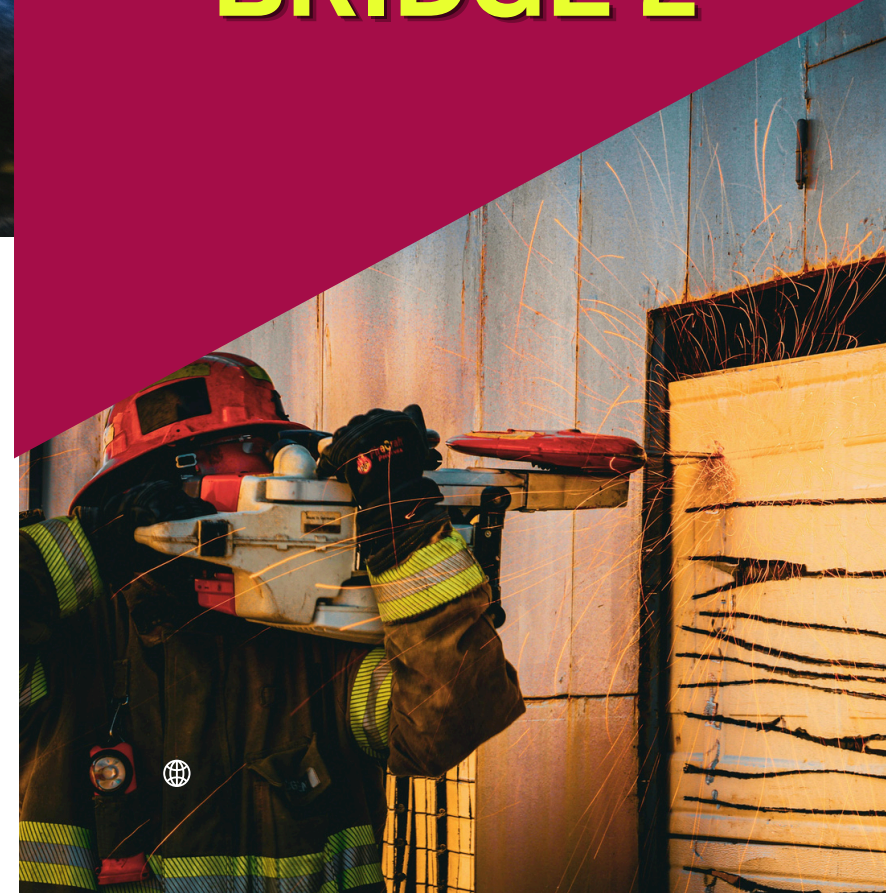
The problem.

Project's solution

The Romania-Ukraine border area faces limited emergency response capacity, fragmented procedures, and weak communication between crisis management institutions, reducing the effectiveness of joint interventions during disasters and hazardous incidents. The project addresses these challenges through a Joint Intervention Plan, upgraded communication and response equipment, shared operational procedures, and cross-border cooperation between Romanian and Ukrainian emergency authorities to strengthen coordinated, rapid, and resilient crisis response.

Project Outcomes

- **Endowment of General Inspectorate for Emergency Situations** (4 Communications and information technology sets, laptops, monitors, interactive white boards, etc)
- **Endowment of MDSESU Odessa** (specially equipped vehicle designed for rapid response to emergencies related to radiation or chemical contamination. It provides for the delivery of rescuers, equipment, reconnaissance, degassing, decontamination, and other necessary measures in contaminated areas)
- **Endowment of IES Suceava** (equipment as: UPS, Patch Analog ports, interactive whiteboards, audio system, camera surveillance, work vehicle, etc)
- **1 Joint Intervention Plan with Associated Procedures** developed
- **10 Workshops** to assess the legal framework organized in Romania and Ukraine and to develop the Joint Intervention Plan and Associated Procedures
- **1 Joint Exercise organised** with 100 participants
