The problem. Project's solution

Schools in the Romania–Ukraine cross-border area face unequal access to quality education due to outdated equipment, limited teacher training, and insufficient intercultural learning opportunities, particularly in rural and disadvantaged communities. The EDUARC project addresses these challenges through cross-border cooperation, modern educational infrastructure, STEM, VR, and language labs, inclusive learning spaces, and joint teacher training programs that promote digital inclusion, resilience, and equal educational opportunities.

Who benefits from the project?

- **255 students** = classroom capacity of new or modernised education facilities
- **340 annual users** of modernised education facilities
- **representatives of local public authorities**

Project Outcomes

- **Endowment of 5 schools in Ardud, Yamnytsia, and Khust** (tools for equipping STEM laboratories, language labs, and virtual reality (VR) labs, a library, as well as outdoor educational equipment to support interactive and inclusive learning, etc).
- **1 joint training** on identifying and addressing behavioral problems - Age- Specific (gymnasium/high school)
- **1 Good practices exchange** for the use of STEM Smart Labs in class for 30 teachers
- **3 created read & relax corners** functioning as a shared mini-library in schools from Ardud, Yamnytsia, and Khust
- **3 schools' online newspaper or magazine (Media Club – The Little Journalist)**, covering topics relevant to their school life, the local community, and the world at large, posted on a shared website
- **1 Joint camp for students** (creative workshops: photography, arts and crafts, and ecological sessions, etc)
- **1 Joint Action Plan developed**
- **3 organisations cooperating across borders**
