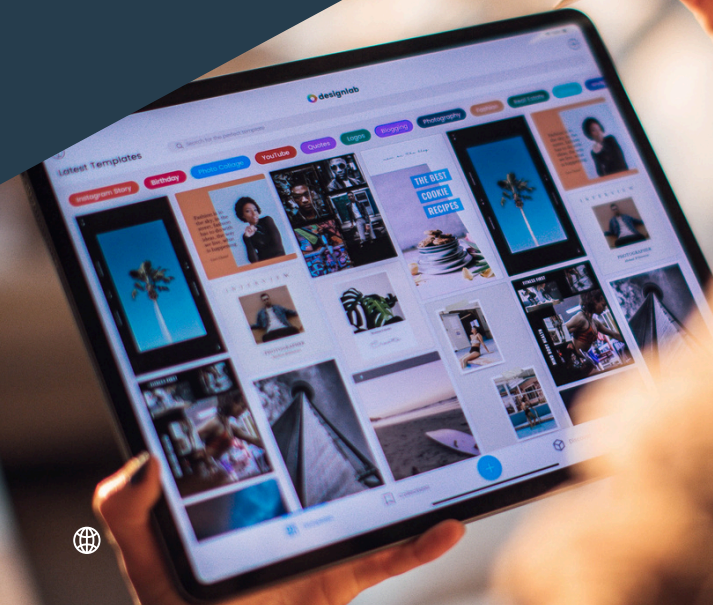

# Cross-border Education Link for accessible and digital learning

## The problem. Project's solution

Children and families in Suceava and Chernivtsi face growing risks from cyberbullying, grooming, and other online threats due to limited digital safety education, contributing to school dropout, social vulnerability, and unequal access to quality learning. The CROSS-EDU LINK project addresses these challenges through cross-border cooperation, bilingual digital safety tools, joint training programmes, and coordinated support from NGOs, schools, and police institutions to strengthen inclusive and resilient digital education.

## Who benefits from the project?

- abt. 60 adults from Suceava County and 60 adults from Chernivtsi Oblast, trained
- abt. 6000 persons from Suceava County and 6000 persons from Chernivtsi Oblast, reached by the awareness campaign
- representatives of local and regional public authorities

## Project Outcomes

- 2 learning centers in Suceava and Chernivtsi, endowed with training equipment (interactive whiteboard, video camera kit, electronic tablets, etc)
- Development of a trilingual user-friendly mobile application to support training and awareness on digital safety
- 1 training for trainers developed
- 1 joint training curriculum developed
- 12 trainings on digital safety organised for 120 persons
- 1 Project website
- 2 online campaigns for promoting the project and mobile application
- 4 organisations cooperating across borders
- launching and closing conferences for about 200 participants
