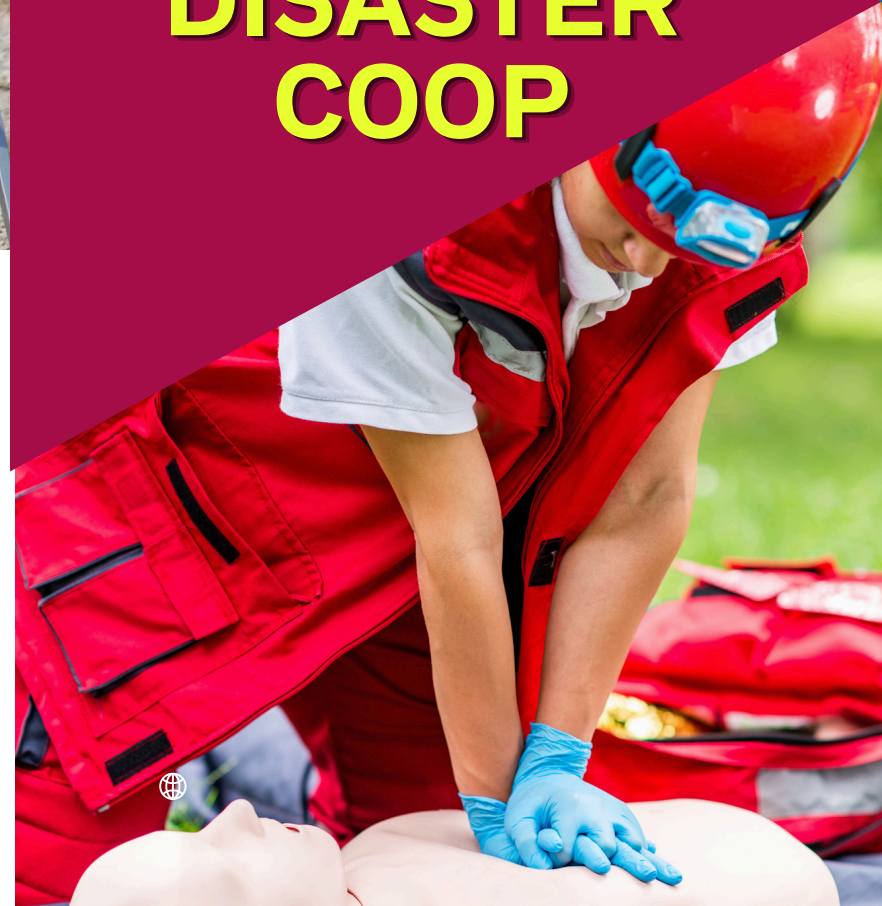

Development of the institutional capacity of Santau Commune and Vynohradiv City in the field of disaster management

The problem. Project's solution

Border communities in Romania and Ukraine face limited emergency response capacity, insufficient resources, and weak preparedness for natural disasters, accidents, and security threats intensified by climate change and the war in Ukraine. The project addresses these challenges through a cross-border cooperation network, joint training and exercises, exchange of expertise, community resilience education, and improved rescue capacity supported by modern firefighting equipment and coordinated crisis management actions.

Who benefits from the project?

- local and regional public authorities
- general public (residents from Santau Commune (2.200 people) and Vynohradiv City (25.317 people))

Project Outcomes

- Endowment of the Santau Commune (Fire Truck with a capacity of 5,000 liters of water and 4x4, with a diesel engine of 320 horsepower, etc.)
- Endowment of the Petrivtsi Village Council (fire truck with a wheel formula of 4x2, a crew of up to 6 people, for extinguishing fires, equipped with a turbodiesel with a capacity of 160 horsepower, electronic equipment, etc.)
- 1 training in First Aid for 240 persons
- 1 training in Disaster Prevention and Intervention for 240 persons
- 3 trainings for 150 volunteers (First Aid, Disaster prevention and Intervention, and Stress Management)
- 4 common exercises with 50 volunteers
- 1 Cross-border joint strategy and intervention protocol in case of disasters developed
- 2 organisations cooperating across borders
